The replica **Shaker-style round barn** houses the J. K. Lilly III Automobile Collection and seasonal exhibition *Born to Ride*, a vintage motorcycle show & the newly opened Gordon T. Heald Conference Center. The **American History Museum** is home to *A Bird in the Hand*; the *Carvings of Elmer and Cleon Crowell*, a new seasonal exhibition *America's Kitchens* organized by Historic New England and a collection of American military miniatures and firearms. The **Art Museum** features a working antique carousel and seasonal exhibition *Flying Horses* which explores the history of this popular amusement. **Hidden Hollow**: An Outdoor Discovery Center, one of the museums newest attractions, is a naturally formed kettle hole that provide the backdrop for families to explore, play and learn. A tree house is scheduled to open this summer. A spectacular **Flume Fountain** with a 26 ft. waterfall drops into a pond in the Don Marvin Daylily Garden. **A Museum Store, Blossoms Café, Old East Mill, labyrinth & Hart Family Maze Garden** are also located on the grounds. 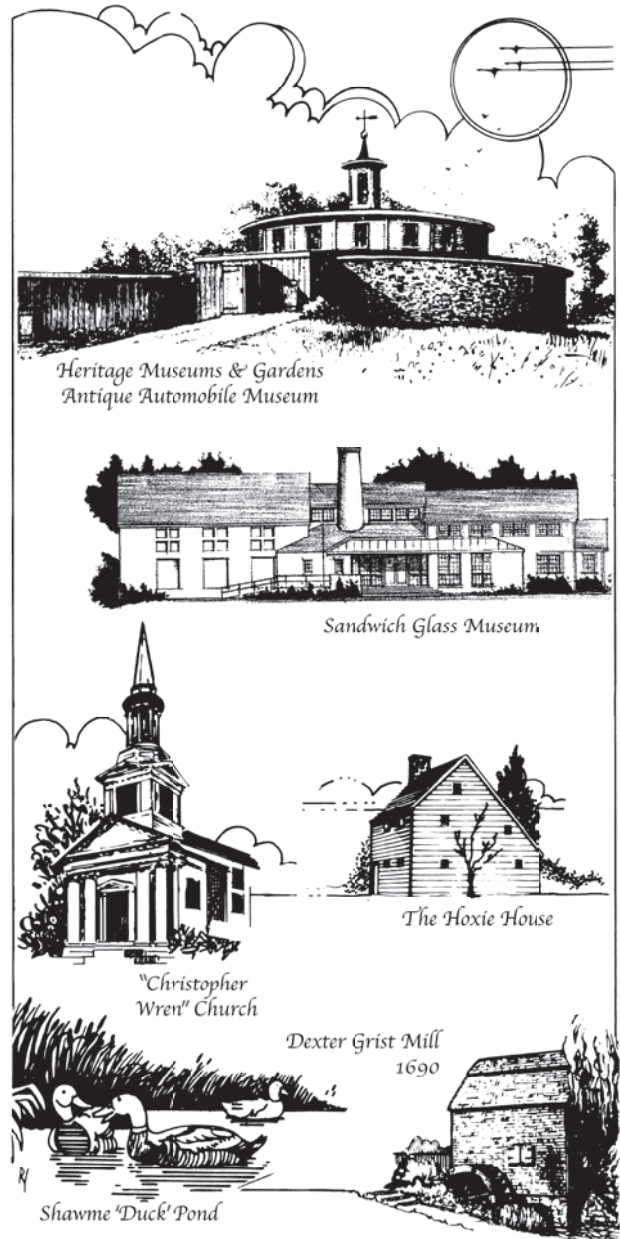

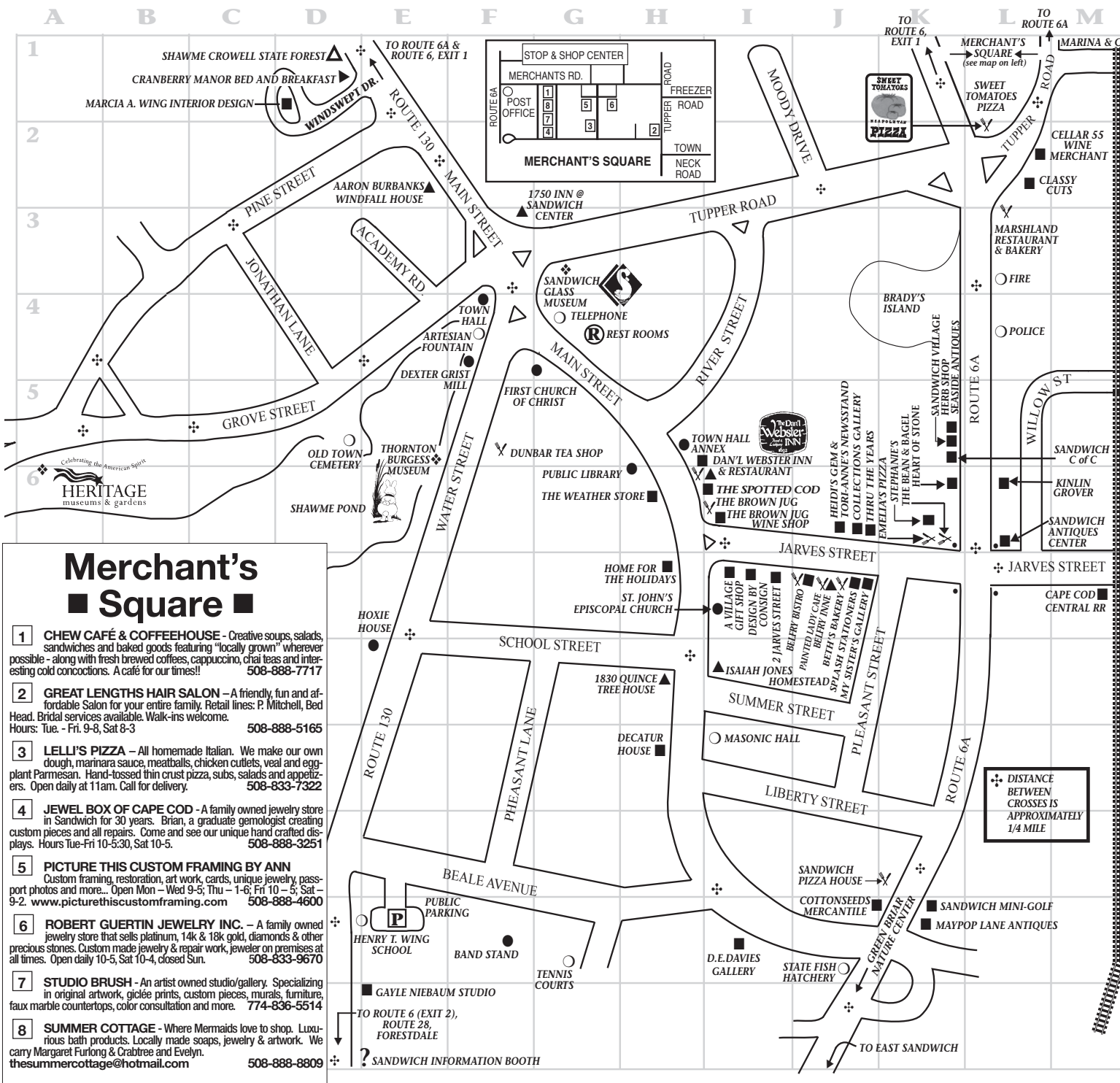

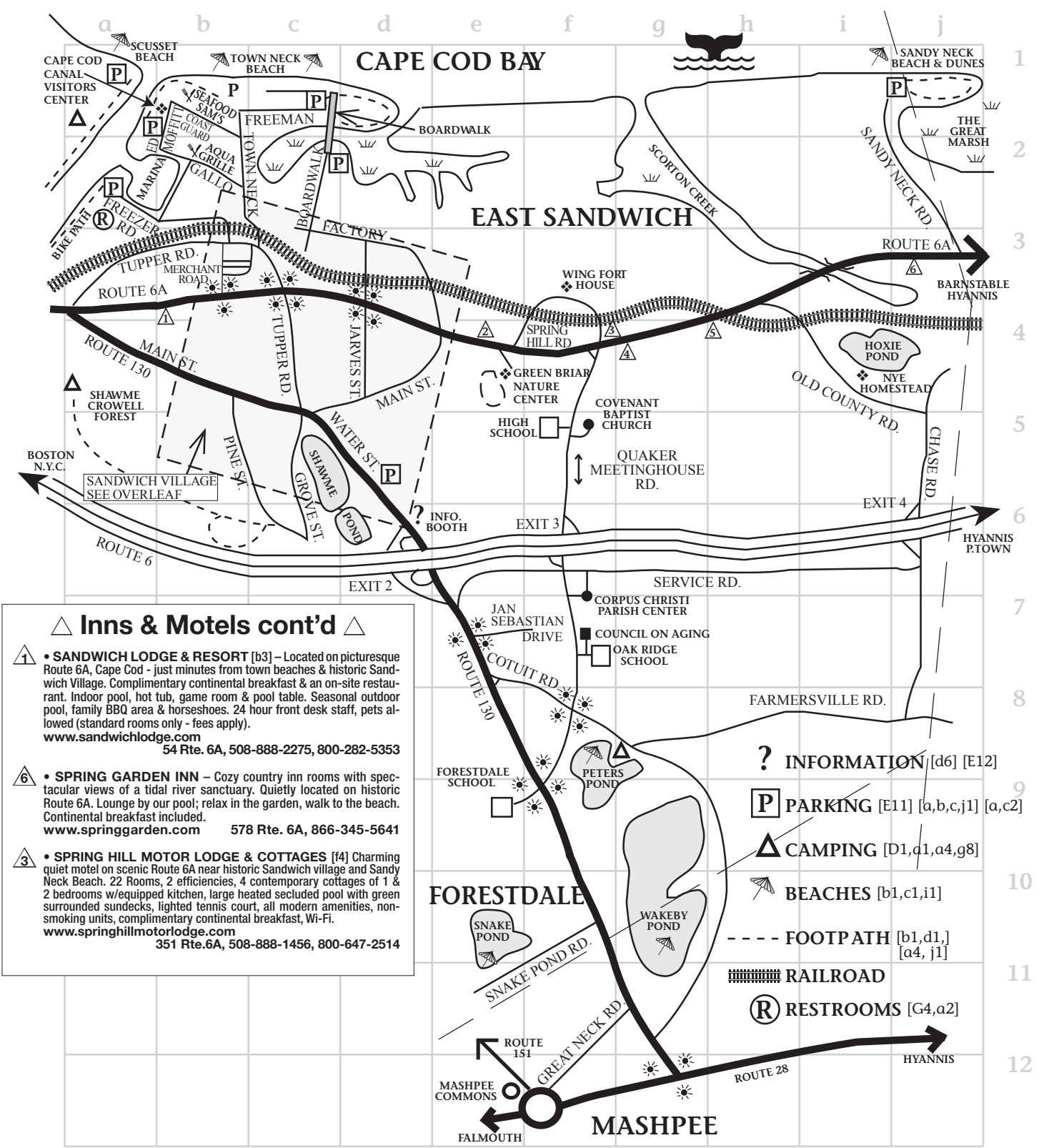
